Highlights from the Ohio House of Representatives Races:

- 65 Republicans and 34 Democrats (Democrats picked up two seats)
- 71 Incumbents won
- 28 New Members will be sworn into office in January.

Returning to the Ohio General Assembly:

- Former State Representative Kyle Koehler will be replacing Senator Bob Hackett in the Ohio Senate.
- Former State Representative Mike Dovilla is returning to the House of Representatives.

Other Notable highlights:

- Current Ohio Senator Stephanie Kunze lost her race for the Ohio House.
- Democrats picked up Rep. David Dobos' seat. Rep. Dobos was not on the ballot
- With JD Vance becoming the Vice President, it opens his seat for Governor DeWine to appoint a U.S. Senator
